



HOW TO GET TO BOLOGNA

By Plane

Several airlines connect Bologna with many Italian and foreign cities. The international airport "G. Marconi" is located just 7 km from the Course Venue.

By Train

The Bologna Central Station is one of the largest railway interconnections in both ltaly and Europe. It is a few minutes from Palazzo della Cultura e dei Congressi. Buses no. 35/39 link the station with the Course Venue.

The prices of the tickets are \bigcirc 1,30 validity: 75 minutes from time of stamping on bus. One-day ticket price is \bigcirc 5,00, validity: 24 hours from time of stamping on bus.

By Car

From motorway A1, A13, A14: from the ring road exit n. 7 (Via Stalingrado) or exit Bologna Fiera direction city centre of Bologna.
